THE ROLE

- Collate, analyse and interpret survey data as well as digitisation and mapping survey results.
- Prepare non-complex ecological reports including write up of some or all of the following report types; baseline ecological surveys, AA screening reports, preliminary ecological assessment and derogation licence applications/returns.
- Contribute to part of more complex reports such as ecological impact assessment and biodiversity chapters of EIARs.
- Manage projects of an appropriate scale relevant to ability and level of experience.

- An honours degree in ecology, natural science or a related biological discipline. A
